The Introductory IAM CD Delivery consists of 2 training modules specifically designed for the following target groups:



Introductory IAM Training Module (1 day): LGU decision makers (mayors, speakers, councillors), Staff of LGU departments responsible for communal affairs (water services), PUC top and middle management, Line ministries, regulators, RCDN Focal Points from LGAs and APUCs and other relevant staff.

Designated IAM Training Module (1 day): Staff of LGU departments responsible for communal affairs, PUC top and middle management.



What will you learn?

Introductory IAM Training Module (1 day):

- **General Aspects** of Integrated Asset Management: what is IAM, objectives and benefits of IAM, getting started in IAM planning and change in business culture
- **Legal Aspects** of IAM: legal framework in managing the assets at the local governance unit (LGU) level, ownership on infrastructure assets (water and wastewater infrastructure), level of service (LoS), public service agreement (PSA) between LGUs and public utility companies (PUCs),
- **Institutional Aspects** of IAM: organization of IAM at the level of LGUs and PUCs, roles and responsibilities in managing assets, IAM procedures at the level of LGUs and PUCs, asset registry and bookkeeping of assets, needs for revalorization of assets, IAM towards the tariff policy/structure, communication and coordination of IAM activities between LGUs and PUCs.

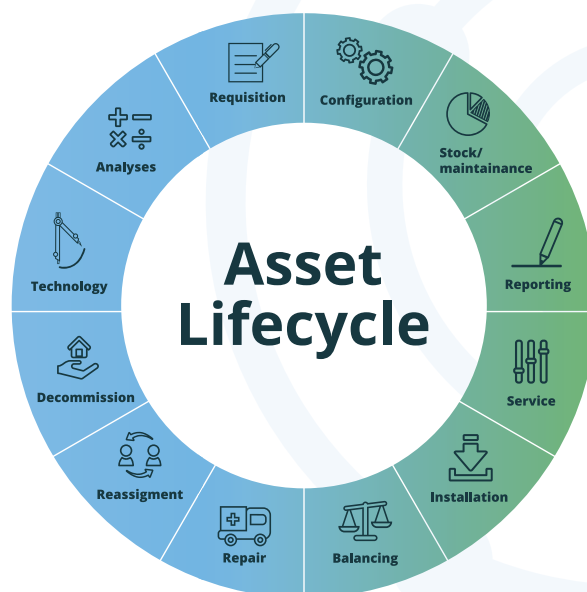
Designated IAM Training Module (1 day):

- **Technical Aspects** of Integrated Asset Management: planning of IAM, managing the lifecycle of infrastructure assets, development of complete asset registry, asset maintenance procedures, asset lifetime and deterioration of assets including critical assets, asset rehabilitation, AM software in function of asset management, monitoring performance and improvement.
- **Financial Aspects** of Integrated Asset Management: Inventory of the fixed assets, revalorization of assets, depreciation of assets, financial management of the assets, IAM and business planning, financing the communal services on full cost recovery principles, funding strategy and capital investment planning.

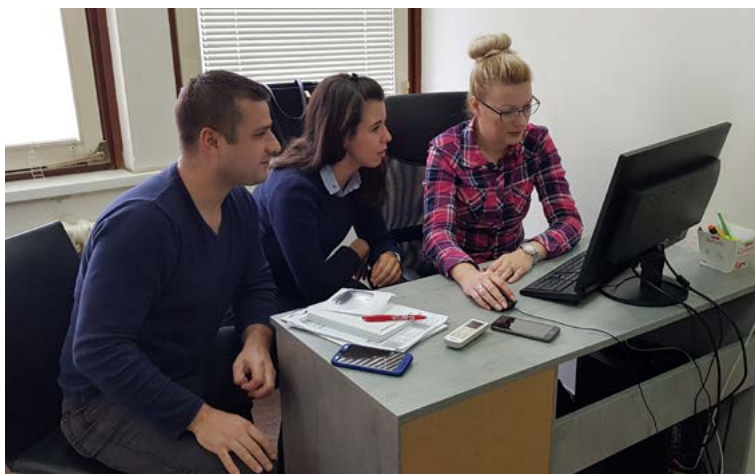


Main benefits:

- Participants understand the IAM concept and its importance, objectives and benefits and they recognize how to apply IAM principles in their job / working places (environment);
- Participants are familiarized with IAM legal and institutional framework and understand their IAM roles and responsibilities;

Who we are?

RCDN aims to increase effectiveness and efficiency of the water utilities in the South-east Europe, contributing to better service provision with larger numbers of population groups getting access to drinking water and sanitation services and meeting the European Union (EU) environmental Acquis Communautaire.

To achieve this, RCDN has main focus on three key areas: 1) Association Development, 2) Capacity Development Offer and Delivery and 3) Partnership and enabling Capacity Development Environment. RCDN is partnership of 16 national associations (LGAs and APUCs) in 6 project countries (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, North Macedonia, Montenegro and Serbia). The final beneficiaries are the top and middle managers from municipal and regional water utility companies and officers in charge in municipalities.

The project which is supporting the Network is managed by GIZ, on behalf of Swiss SECO and German BMZ, and is implemented by a Project Implementation Team that consists of three regional networks IAWD, AQUASAN Network in B&H and NALAS.

Asset management is the basis for the operation of a water utility company. By knowing your own infrastructure you can assess its conditions but also risks, which affects the operational and financial planning of material and human resources at the level of water utility company. It is very important that the company allocates funds for investment maintenance from the tariff, and the basis for this is established asset registry, i.e. the entire water and sewage infrastructure recorded in the business books of the company. The registry forms the basis for the calculation of depreciation that has to be financed from the tariff, thus contributing to successful and sustainable performance of the company.
